Cookies are small text files a web server sends to the browser that can be placed on your computer or mobile device to uniquely identify your browser or device. Cookies allow a site to know if your device has visited that site before. This allows the website to recognize your visit from those of other users of the website. Cookies used by the site do not contain your personally identifiable information. Cookies are used for system improvement and administration, statistical analysis purposes, and other internal business purposes.
